

**HEARD COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS CALLED MEETING  
JUNE 11, 2019 – 5:00 P.M.**

The Heard County Board of Commissioners held a Called Commissioners Meeting on June 11, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. in the Commission Chamber of the Heard County Administration Building. In attendance at the meeting were Chairman Lee Boone, District 1 Commissioner Larry Hooks, District 2 Commissioner Keri Denney, District 3 Commissioner Gwen Caldwell, District 4 Commissioner Larry Hammond, and District 5 Commissioner David Walls.

**Agenda Item # 2 - Welcome, Invocation, and Pledge to the American Flag** - Chairman Boone called the meeting to order, welcomed everyone present and gave the invocation.

**Agenda Item # 3 – Public Hearing – Public Hearing on FY2019-2020 Budget** – Chairman Boone opened the public hearing and asked for any public comments. There were no comments from the public. Chairman Boone asked for any comments from the Board. There were no comments from the Board. There being no comments from the public and no comments from the Board, on motion (Denney) and second (Hooks), the Board unanimously agreed to close the public hearing.

**Agenda Item # 4 – Amend Agenda** – None.

**Agenda Item # 5 – New Business – a. Approve List of Heard County Roads for Speed Detection Devices** – Chairman Boone stated that Sheriff Ross Henry recently asked him to present a list of the Heard County roads and their posted speed limits on each road to the Board for their approval. This list has been amended due to include roads inside the Town of Centralhatchee. He stated these roads are now certified by the Department of Transportation (DOT) and the speed limit signs are posted in Centralhatchee so Heard County deputies can now enforce the speed limits. On motion (Hammond) and second (Caldwell), the Board unanimously approved the list of Heard County roadways and their speed limits.

**Agenda Item # 6 – Public Comments** – Chairman Boone updated the Board on the solid waste disposal issues that the county has recently been experiencing. He stated that he wanted the Board to be aware that there may need to be a decision made quickly on a solid waste vendor.

There being no further business, on motion (Caldwell) and second (Denney), the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.
