#### b. Discuss Award of Grant for Scrap Tire Disposal

District 2 Commissioner Perry applied for and secured the STAR Grant, a state-funded program that reimburses local governments for the collection, transport, and recycling of scrap tires. Through this grant, the County will host a tire amnesty event on January 10, 2026, at the Heard County Covered Arena, beginning at 9:00 a.m. This event is for Heard County residents only. Residents may dispose of up to 10 tires per household, limited to passenger car and truck tires; oversized tires, tractor tires, and other large tires will not be accepted. The event will conclude once the trailer has been fully loaded.

#### c. Announce the Approval for Repairs on West Ferry Road

Georgia Power has agreed to cover the cost of repairs to West Ferry Road, which has sustained significant damage from the heavy traffic of dump trucks entering and exiting the site during ongoing cleanup operations. The Board expressed appreciation for Georgia Power's willingness to address the issue, noting that the repairs will help ensure the road remains safe and accessible for residents and other traffic while cleanup activities continue.
